## 2019 Membership Benefits

Australian subsidiaries of global signatories to the UN Global Compact can join the Global Compact Network Australia, by completing a [membership application form](#) (see also the GCNA's [Constitution](#)) and paying the relevant membership fee.

Companies can choose between two tiers of participation: Participant or Signatory. The following table outlines the membership contribution fee and benefits that apply for each tier.
