

Global Compact Network Australia: 2021 Membership Benefits – Subsidiary Organisations

Business signatories to the UN Global Compact can choose between two tiers of engagement: [Signatory or Participant](#). The financial contribution is based on the tier chosen and the business' annual revenue. Australian subsidiaries of global entities must follow the [Subsidiary Policy of the UN Global Compact](#):

- Subsidiaries of parent organisations that are at the participant-tier, the Australian subsidiary must join at the participant-tier.
- Subsidiaries of parent organisations that are at the signatory-tier, can join at either the participant-tier or signatory-tier. If the subsidiary decides to join at the participant-tier, the full global fee is applicable and is based on the Australian subsidiary's revenue.
- Consolidated entity fee is only applicable to subsidiaries of Australian parent companies (e.g. Officeworks and Bunnings which are subsidiaries of Wesfarmers). Consolidated entities must submit an application as a subsidiary organisation through the UN Global Compact.
